Water Line Replacement Commercial Street

The Bath Water District with the assistance of Hagar Construction will be replacing 1000 ft of aged 6” Cast Iron pipe on Commercial Street with a proposed start date of September 24, 2018. The scope of the work will involve installing new valves, new 8” Ductile Iron pipe, and new service connections. The purpose of the work is to improve water quality and quantity as well as dependability.

During the week of September 17th members of the Bath Water District distribution crew will be in the area setting up customers with temporary water service in preparation for the replacement of the existing water line. The temporary water lines will be laid out on top of the ground and connected to businesses through outside hose bibs. The crew will try to locate the piping so it doesn’t interfere with daily tasks. Once the temporary water lines are tested and put into service the water line replacement in the roadway can commence.

Hagar Construction will begin the installation of the new water main the week of September 24th. Construction will start in Phase 1(Lambard St. to Broad St.) The pipe work and paving will be completed in this phase before moving to Phase 2 (Broad St. to Summer St.) We anticipate the project taking 30 days to complete and ask for your patience and understanding during the process. Commercial Street is a busy street in the city and not an ideal one for construction. Bath Water District and Hagar Construction will do our best to keep you informed with notifications, meetings, our website(bathwd.org), and Facebook. When a schedule is developed we will post that on our website as well.
